

Preschool Teacher Position Available

Position Available: Preschool Teacher to work Monday-Friday; hours likely from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. We are open year-round and this person will work as our Two's Teacher in the mornings, and in the afternoons helping with ages two through five in any of our three classrooms.

Requirements: We are a play-based Christian preschool in downtown Napa. Applicants must be comfortable singing preschool Christian songs and doing a very simple prayer before meals. Must be able and willing to assist with diapering and potty training and able to lift children on and off the changing table. Additional state licensing requirements below.

Benefits: We are a fun place to work and have low ratios in our classrooms. Free childcare during work hours if you have a child age two through five. Medical/Dental/Vision benefits available. We offer 21 paid holiday days each year and 10 days of sick leave.

General Responsibilities:

- Support co-workers in classroom with daily activities
- Help prepare snack
- Plan, prepare, implement and clean-up activities and projects
- Help maintain classroom, materials, and outdoor play area
- Ability to attend once a month evening staff meeting
- Capable of managing a group of preschoolers
- Must be willing to work as a team with our preschool staff

Applicants must meet the following state requirements:

- At least 6 months experience as a preschool teacher in a licensed childcare center or comparable group childcare program.
- Prefer 12 units of college Child Development classes, but we would consider someone with only six units but they must include Child Development and Child Family and Community. If selected to interview, you will need to bring a transcript (unofficial is okay) to verify completion of units. *You are welcome to apply if you are currently taking Child Development classes but we will need to see your transcript thus far.*
- Ability to pass a physical exam that includes a TB test. Proof of vaccination or Immunity for Measles and Pertussis, and Infant and Child First Aid and CPR certification.
- Ability to obtain criminal record clearance.
- Must be familiar with the requirements for providing the type of care and supervision needed by children, including the ability to visually supervise the children at all times & never leave any child unattended.
